SUPPORTING MATERIALS:

Work samples should be from the proposed project (if possible) or from past work.

Samples should include:

Lyricists/Composers: mp3 recordings of 3 songs, with lyric sheets and context. If applying as a team (recommended), one selection should be the song from the scene submitted by bookwriter/librettist.

Bookwriters/Librettists: One complete scene with song, 10-15 pages.

Audio files should be sent as **mp3**, one selection per email.

Text files (including project proposal, resume and text work samples) should be sent as **PDF** (preferred) or **MS Word (.doc)**.
